Attribution (Weiner, 1985)

how an individual explains the causes of another person's behavior

Social & Cognitive psychology

What do you think is the cause?

Tendency to attribute cause to behavior



Dimension

Locus of control: To choose whether the responsibility for a particular event should be placed on internal or external factors

Stability: Whether the cause is stable or unstable

Control-ability: controllable or uncontrollable

Attribution	Cause	Stability	Control-ability
Ability	Internal	stable	uncontrollable
Effort	Internal	unstable	controllable
Luck	External	unstable	uncontrollable
task difficulty	external	stable	uncontrollable

Pros and Cons

• model to analyze many of the emotional behaviors that operate in the classroom

 difficult to develop classes to implement attribution theory in real classrooms

 classroom process is not developed enough to apply attribution theory
